The Better Futures and Homestretch program aims to engage with Young People leaving care, providing individualised supports including housing, health and wellbeing, education, employment, and community and cultural connections.



The Senior Worker will be instrumental to leading the small team and engaging with of the Young People and their Carers to confirm their eligibility and gaining the Young Person's consent to be referred to a Better Futures and Homestretch service provider.

The position requires:

- Experience working with Young People, Carers and Families.
- Understanding of the barriers and challenges facing Young People and Carers in Permanent Care and trauma informed approaches.
- Knowledge of Child Protection, Out of Home Care, Child, and Family Services sectors.
- Experience in leading a small team.
- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills and a positive and enthusiastic manner.

Lived Experience of the Out of Home Care sector would be viewed favourably.

Recruitment - Board Positions

Call for nominations for Directors to be elected to the Board of Permanent Care and Adoptive Families Inc. at the Annual General Meeting on the 8th November 2023.

PCA Families is seeking to appoint up to three Directors, two who have personal and family connections to Permanent Care and Adoption and one of whom does not have involvement with permanent care and adoption but is interested in becoming a Director.

The following key skills have been identified for recruitment by the Board. Our hope is that the two Directors who have a personal and family connections to Permanent Care and Adoption will also be able to fill the skill gaps below:

- Influencer-demonstrated links potential to funders. i.e., Government departments/philanthropy.

Petition for Butterfly Foundation

The Butterfly Foundation need help to reach 10,000 signatures for Butterfly and Dove's petition for a National Inquiry into Body Image by the end of August.

The inquiry aims to kick-start a national conversation about what policies and programs may be needed to bring about real change in body ideals in Australia, including understanding the prevalence and full impact of body dissatisfaction, and the role played by social media. It would also provide a forum to hear from researchers, clinicians, professionals who work with kids, parents, people with lived experience and others about the problems and potential solutions. This is critical for supporting the current generation of young people and protecting the generations to come.

Help us reach our target signatures so we can raise the alarm with Australian Parliament that this is a substantial community issue that urgently needs addressing.


