The 2023 budget was considered a first step budget by not for profits. Our Community Matters 2023 budget edition describes the budget as 3.5 lamingtons out of 5 for the sector, recognising that many community organisation rely on fundraising to survive. The overall intent was positive yet sustainable significant investment in programs and services is still lacking and there is still work to do to lift people out of poverty and to target support towards disadvantaged and children. 


News - Envisaging Schools

Despite continuous reforms and investment, educational performance in Australia's schools is considered questionable. Australia's PISA scores (Performance International Student Assessment) have dropped in maths, NAPLAN (National Assessment Program) has been stagnant or declining, achievement gaps exist in different equity groups (rural/indigenous or socio educationally disadvantaged) and spending has gone up by 22%. So what could a new vision for schools look like? A whole child and whole school approach that optimises opportunities for all children to grow up as the individuals they want to become? TOPIC: EXERCISE PHYSIOLOGY

DATE: Wednesday 24 May 12.00 to 1.00pm



TOPIC: Robyn Papworth is a paediatric exercise physiologist, developmental educator and trainer who is passionate about helping children's body and brain to be ready for kindergarten and school through movement and play strategies. In her YouTube recording with PCA Families, Robyn reminds us that movement development can be fun and there are critical milestones that are part of a progression, not a race to deliver at a point in time. She shares exercises we can do to help with visual tracking, core strength, crossing the midline, spatial awareness and shoulder stabilisation, all key elements to sit in a classroom and learn. She reminds us to connect feelings and visuals with letters, not to teach the ABCs. We need to meet the child with where they are at.
